**Lodge Scholarship Application**

As superior scholarship needs to be acknowledged, the Lodge has established a Student Merit Scholarship Fund to recognize and reward academic excellence in our youth. All scholarship awards will be allocated on an objective basis as the applicant must be a high school graduate accepted into or a student currently attending an accredited college, university or vocational technical school on a full-time undergraduate basis and shall have an academic grade point average of 3.0 or greater, based on a 4.0 grading system.

The Lodge Scholarship Program is available to sons, daughters, grandsons, granddaughters or legally established guardians of living Franklin/St. John's/Trinity Lodge members in good Masonic Standing.

Candidates must apply in writing using a current Lodge Scholarship Application; indicating their current grade point average and, in addition, will include a brief statement indicating why they should be considered for a scholarship award. All candidates must be sponsored by a living Franklin/St. John's/Trinity Lodge member in good Masonic Standing. In order to be considered, all applications will include a signature of the sponsoring member validating their support and agreement to do so.

**General Instructions for Applicants:**

1. Candidates must use the current year's official Application. The Application is set forth on page three (3) of this document and is also available on the Lodge website ([www.palodge221@gmail.com](mailto:www.palodge221@gmail.com)) filed under the "Resources" drop down tab. Application forms from previous years will not be considered as Lodge Scholarship requirements are subject to change.
2. Complete the Application in its entirety; incomplete Applications will not be considered.
3. Include required attachments:
  - a. Official Transcript or copy of grades from your most recent completed academic year.
  - b. Student ID or a letter of acceptance on letterhead of the accredited certified learning institution.
4. Obtain a signature from your Sponsor.
5. Sign and date the Application.

Completed Applications and required attachments must be hand delivered to the Secretary, taking his receipt therefore or postmarked and returned to the same, by the Application deadline of **April 15, 2021** to the following address:

**Scholarship Application Guidelines**

**Applicant Qualifications:**

1. Applicant must be a son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter or an established legal guardianship of a living member in good Masonic Standing of Franklin/St. John's/Trinity Lodge No. 221.
2. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and a high school graduate or have a certified GED diploma who has been accepted into or is a student currently attending an accredited university, college, or vocational technical school as a full-time undergraduate student. The applicant must be between the age of 17 and 24.
3. Applicant will be required to submit with a valid Application copies of a student ID, and an official transcript from the recognized accredited institution. In lieu of a student ID, the applicant will submit a letter of acceptance on letterhead of the accredited certified learning institution.
4. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher based on a 4.0 GPA grading system.
5. Applicants qualifying for the Scholarship award will be asked to appear at dinner prior to a Stated Meeting of the Lodge to accept the award check (date to be determined by the Worshipful Master). In lieu of attendance, the successful applicant(s) must submit a letter verifying receipt of the award.
6. Recipients may apply annually up to four (4) years of undergraduate education.
