Project 2020 – The Vision for the Lodge's Future

1. 20 Degrees
 - a. First, Second, and/or Thirds
 - b. Equivalent of 6 new members, plus two “loose”
2. 20 new Ritual units
 - a. A “Ritual Unit” is a member becoming proficient in a piece of ritual, whether for meetings, degrees, both, etc.
3. 20 member attendance average per meeting
4. 20 “returns” of members that missed the last 20 or more meetings (2 years)
5. 20 visitors/half year
6. 20 different members visiting another Lodge (outside of DDGM visits)
7. Establish contact with 20 Lodges outside of PA
 - a. Freemasonry is about fraternal brotherhood, and that extends beyond borders
 - b. Illustrate just how big of a family we have
8. 20 “nuggets” of wisdom shared from 20 different Brothers
 - a. Articles or messages for the website
9. 20 members attend a District event
10. At least \$20/meeting to Help for Heroes/Change for the Troops
11. 20 care packages to soldiers
12. 20 members represent the Lodge at community events
 - a. Autumn Days at Elizabethtown, events at MVS, parades, etc.
13. 20 books donated to charity book drives
14. 20 commendations/thank you messages to members of the Lodge
 - a. Mostly outside our control, but gratitude will come to members who serve others
15. 20 new items for the Lodge website
16. 20 Masonic lessons at meetings
17. 20 charitable contributions
18. 20 material improvements to the Lodge
 - a. New regalia, fixed furniture, etc. at direction of Furniture Committee findings
 - b. Could be as simple as tidying up the storage closets if need be
19. Find 20 items of Lodge history
20. As a Lodge, simply try 20 new things
